Cabcharge Australia Limited ("Cabcharge") today announced the second quarter 2009 results of its joint venture entities – ComfortDelGro Cabcharge Pty Ltd ("CDC") and CityFleet UK Pte Ltd ("CityFleet UK").

CDC is the joint venture Company that operates Westbus with Cabcharge holding 49% and ComfortDelGro Corporation Limited (Singapore) holding 51%.

The results for CDC for the second quarter ended 30 June 2009 were as follows:

- Turnover of \$62.5m which represents an increase of 42% equating to \$18.5m over the same quarter ended 30 June 2008.
- Increased EBIT of \$10.8m up by \$3.8m or 54% over the same quarter ended 30 June 2008.

CityFleet UK is the joint venture Company that provides Taxi Services throughout the United Kingdom. Cabcharge increased its holdings in CityFleet UK to 49% from 33% on 19 June 2008. ComfortDelGro holds the remaining 51%.

The results for the UK operations for the second quarter ended 30 June 2009 were as follows:

- Turnover of \$A35.6m which represents a decrease of \$A8.7m from the same quarter ended 30 June 2008
- Decreased EBIT of \$A1.9m down by \$A0.9m from the same quarter ended 30 June 2008

Executive Chairman of Cabcharge, Mr. Reg Kermode attributed the increase of the CDC results to contributions from the Kefford acquisition in Victoria and growth in NSW as a result of the NSW Government Bus Growth Program which will be more significant in CDC's 2H09.

Mr. Kermode said the UK operations although profitable, remain disappointing. However, we have noted some positive signs of growth emerging from increased economic activity and success with securing a significant contract.
